JILL NADINE CLEMENTS: GOOD SCENTS

In April the *East-West Journal* featured an item on Nadina's Cremes, a Baltimore-based manufacturer of all-natural body creams. Since then, owner Jill Nadine Clements has received orders from twenty stores around the country who want to carry her product (it's already sold in about one hundred shops from Maine to Hawaii). She's thrilled, but she's also worried that the people who make the pottery containers for the cream—ten Baltimore potters and a group of developmentally disabled adults in Arnold—will have trouble keeping up with the orders.

The pottery jars are crucial because Clements, 30, won't use plastic bottles or anything else she considers environmentally unsound in her product. Her scented creams, which she makes in her Parkville kitchen, contain only natural ingredients: beeswax, aloe, almond oil, coconut oil, and essential oils. She makes them without animal testing and donates 3 percent of her proceeds to environmental groups and charities.

Clements, an environmental sciences graduate of Texas A&M University, would welcome wider distribution of her product, "but only if it keeps its uniqueness and genuineness."
